



Billing Arrangement & Fees

We BULK BILL patients who have a valid Pension Card, Health Care Card, Commonwealth Seniors Card, Veteran Affairs Card and Children under 16 years. Exceptions include procedures in the treatment room and home visits.

We privately bill adults without a concession card and persons not covered by Medicare. All fees are payable following your consultation. Payment can be made by cash, EFTPOS and credit card (VISA & MasterCard). If you have difficulty settling your account, please discuss this with us prior to your consultation.

Reminder System

This Practice runs a reminder system for recalling patients for review of numerous health conditions eg. cervical screening, blood pressure checks, cholesterol reviews and health assessments. Cervical screening information is automatically forwarded to the National Cancer Screening Registry, if you do not wish to be included in any of these reminder systems please let us know.

Test Results

Patients are asked to make a follow-up appointment for review of their test results.

Patient Responsibility

Our practice takes an active approach to ensure the best outcomes for patients at all times even if they choose to reject management advice. Patients should notify the doctor if they want to refuse a specific advice or procedure.

Telephone Access

Our GP's can be contacted during normal surgery hours. If the doctor is with a patient, a message will be taken. We will advise you when it is likely the doctor will return your call. Your call will always be put through to the doctor in an emergency.
